## **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Operating Roll Off trucks to transport waste materials from residential, commercial, and industrial sites to designated disposal or recycling facilities.
- Safely driving and maneuvering Roll Off trucks on roads, highways, and construction sites in compliance with traffic regulations and company policies.
- Conducting pre- and post-trip inspections of the vehicle to ensure its safe and efficient operation, including checking tires, brakes, lights, and other components.
- Assisting in the loading and unloading of Roll Off containers using hydraulic hoists and/or electric winch systems.
- Securing loads properly to prevent spills, leaks, and other hazardous situations during transportation.

- Interacting with customers in a professional and courteous manner, addressing their inquiries and providing assistance as needed.
- Maintaining accurate records of daily activities, including disposal tickets, fuel receipts, and maintenance needed/performed on the vehicle.
- Following all safety guidelines and protocols to minimize accidents, injuries, and property damage.
