Job Purpose

The CDL Commercial Driver – This position combines driving responsibilities with the ability to ensure high customer service and maintain the roll-off yard. The Commercial Driver ensures all assigned tasks are completed safely, efficiently, and in compliance with company and regulatory standards while delivering exceptional customer service.

Duties and Responsibilities

Duties and Responsibilities include but are not limited to

Driving Responsibilities

- Perform driving duties as required, ensuring timely and safe delivery and pickup of containers.
- Conduct pre-and post-trip inspections to identify and address any issues promptly.
- Communicate with the Maintenance Team to ensure proper asset repair & maintenance.
- Communicate with dispatch and customers to confirm schedules, addresses, and any special instructions.
- Efficiently use the OBC tablet regarding dispatch, disposal, and trip times.
- Remain in compliance with all State, Federal, and Company laws, regulations, and policies.
- Maintain a clean driving record.
- Use safe and efficient driving techniques, proper use of equipment, and company policies.
- Promote a culture of safety within all County Waste Service personnel.
- Ensure compliance with all DOT regulations and company safety policies.
- Participate in regular safety meetings and audits to ensure compliance and awareness company wide.

Roll-Off Yard Management

- Maintain the organization and cleanliness of the CWS Roll-Off yard.
- Manage inventory of containers and equipment.
- Coordinate with dispatch and operations to ensure efficient use of resources.

Qualifications

Qualifications include:

- Valid CDL (Commercial Driver's License) with a clean driving record
- Strong knowledge of vehicle maintenance and repair.
- Excellent communication and organizational skills.

- Commitment to safety and compliance.
- Excellent customer service skills and knowledge.

Working Conditions

The Commercial Driver – may work in various conditions and can be exposed to extreme heat, cold, humidity, precipitation, dusty conditions, mechanical parts, electrical hazards, hazardous chemicals, and noxious fumes and odors in both indoor and outdoor environments. Travel and working in various locations may be required occasionally.
